General Lodge use behaviour standards for AAC Dinner Plain members:

The AAC Dinner Plain Lodge is for the shared enjoyment of members their families and their guests, without gender, social, racial, political or religious discrimination.

Members must accept responsibility for the behaviour of their family and guests through appropriate introduction to the lodge and on going supervision.

All members and guests must:

- Consider the safety and well-being of others at all times.
- Recognise that all individuals and groups have a proportionate right to communal spaces at the lodge.
- Be as tolerant of noise and excitement as they are of the preference for quiet and privacy.
- Understand that rude, aggressive, intoxicated behaviour or offensive language will not be tolerated.
- Respect and care for the lodge and its contents.
- Keep any communal spaces/equipment they use clean and tidy, leaving it as they found it.
- Be responsible for the security of the lodge, personal property and respectful of the property of others.
- Alert the Managers/other members of any equipment faults, concerns, illness, injury or safety hazard.
- Follow all signage within the lodge and the directions of the Manager/Caretaker/Member in residence at the time.

A member may be expelled from the co-operative by special resolution if they seriously or repetitively

- fail to work cooperatively within these guidelines or
- act in a way that prevents or hinders the co-operative carrying out one or more of its primary activities or
- brings the co-operative into disrepute.
